

IETF PROTOCOL BADGE LICENSE TERMS

You may use an IETF Protocol Badge to describe your involvement in relevant IETF standards development activities, and to promote products or services that implement or support the relevant protocol, subject to your agreement to these IETF Protocol Badge License Terms:

- You are granted a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, worldwide license to use the relevant IETF Protocol Badge solely to accurately demonstrate and promote your involvement with, support of, and implementation of the relevant protocol or specification described in the applicable IETF Protocol Badge.
- Your licensed use of any IETF Protocol Badge is subject to the following restrictions:
 - Your use of an IETF Protocol Badge may not create a sense of endorsement or sponsorship by the Internet Engineering Task Force, the IETF Trust, Internet Research Task Force, the Internet Society, the Internet Architecture Board, the Internet Engineering Steering Group, or the IETF Administration LLC or imply a false association with any of those entities or groups.
 - For example, you may use an IETF Protocol Badge to indicate that a product or service supports the relevant protocol, if true. You may also use an IETF Protocol Badge to describe your actual involvement in the development of the applicable protocol. You may not use the IETF Protocol Badge in a way that implies that IETF has approved or endorsed that product or service, or that falsely represents your affiliation with the IETF.
 - Your use of an IETF Protocol Badge must not depict the IETF or its related entities and activities in a false or derogatory light.
 - The format, capitalization, proportions and color of an IETF Protocol Badge must be as set forth at <https://www.ietf.org/badges> and may not be modified in any way. You may not shorten, abbreviate or modify an IETF Protocol Badge or use it as part of a combined mark.

This license to the IETF Protocol Badge(s) does not grant you any rights to use any other IETF trademark or logo, which are subject to the [license requirements of the IETF Trust](#).

The IETF Trust may terminate the rights and licenses granted to you with respect to an IETF Protocol Badge at any time and for any reason in its sole discretion. Upon notice of such termination, you will cease all use of the IETF Protocol Badge at issue.
